QUALIFICATIONS: The applicant must be a senior and have an interest in, knowledge of and skill in the game of golf; a minimum grade point average of 3.0 (current transcripts, including fall semester of senior year, that must accompany her application), good citizenship and a willingness to further her education. She also must have played golf on a girls' high school team in Northern Nevada.

DEADLINE: Applications and the coach's report's must be returned through email or postmarked by May 1st of every year. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship money will be sent directly to the college, university, or trade school of the recipient's choice.

The Northern Nevada Junior Golf Association Junior Connections Girls' Golf Scholarship was started by Junior Connection, Inc. through partnership with the Northern Nevada Women's Golf Association. We awarded \$10,000 in scholarships over the past two years.
